

TALK GLOBAL STUDY VIRTUAL FAIRS

*A unique opportunity to talk directly with more than 80 universities
from over 23 countries*

Since 2015, the *Global Education Fairs* have taken place twice a year in Vietnam and are considered the leading international education fairs in Vietnam – with the last events (in 2019) organized in association with the Vietnam Ministry of Education & Training (MOET). The events have provided tens of thousands of students with the necessary tools to take the important final steps towards realising their goal of studying overseas.

Students, their parents, and executives from across Vietnam used this opportunity to talk directly with experts and universities from across the world. During these chats, they have been able to understand the many advantages of an international education and the significant boost an overseas experience gives to their future employment opportunities.

The next in-person *Global Education Fairs* were due to take place in October 2020, but it soon became obvious when the Covid-19 pandemic began that this would be impossible. BMI have therefore been developing an innovative online digital platform which will allow the same events, but in an online format designed for Vietnamese students.

These events are called **Talk Global Study** and will take place on **Saturday 10th October 2020** beginning at 15:00 Hanoi.

Talk Global Study comprises of 4 unique events running simultaneously on 10th October - each focused on a different subject area that are popular with Vietnamese students:

- University & Postgraduate Courses
- Art, Design and Media Courses
- Engineering Courses
- Business, Finance, Management & MBA Courses

The virtual events will feature education pavilions from ***Study in Hungary, Study in Macau, Education in Ireland, the USA*** as well universities from the Canada, UK, Australia, France, Singapore, Japan, Canada, Italy, Switzerland and many more. Students will be able to speak directly with senior admissions staff, alumni, and professors from the participating international institutions by text chat, audio and video and students will get immediate answers to any questions they have about the wide range of courses available internationally.

Students may also participate and ask questions in the interactive live Seminars presented by experts in international education and major government organizations. Topics which will be covered by the live Seminars, and which can also be discussed in the private meetings, include:

- Visa process & requirements
- Application deadlines
- Course fees and financing
- Accommodation options
- Cost of living abroad
- Campus culture and diversity
- What is the latest on Covid-19 and are on Campus studies taking place?
